

35TH SAFRA ANNUAL GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP - RULES & REGULATIONS

28 Sep 2025, Keppel Club, Sime Course

Format of Play

The 35th SAFRA Annual Golf Championship shall consist a single round of 18-hole and play at Keppel Club (KC), in accordance with the rules currently adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of Saint Andrews (R&A), the United States Golf Association (USGA), the local rules of KC and the game rules set by the organising committee.

The tournament format shall be **Stableford point** using System 36 handicapping. Use of normal range finder without measurement of gradient is allowed.

Eligibility

The Championship is open to all members from SAFRA Golfing Section, SAFRA, Home Team, Keppel Club, NSmen, Ex-NSmen, all Singaporean, PR and invited guests who are amateur golfers in accordance with the R&A's and USGA's Rules of Amateur Status and who have a valid current handicap of 24 (men) or 36 (ladies) or less. All golfers are assumed to have their own golf insurance for the game.

Registration

Registration Forms without payment will not be confirmed. The registration fee will be refunded if a golfer's entry is not accepted. There will, however, be no refund if a golfer fails to turn up or withdraws after his application has been accepted.

Closing Date

The closing date for all entries is Wednesday, 22 Sep 2025. All completed forms must reach the Organizing Secretary on or before the closing date. Uncompleted forms or forms without payment will not be considered. The total number of participants is limited to 144 players only.

Divisions

There shall be five divisions (by course handicap) as follows: -

a) Division A : Handicap 0 - 15 b) Division B : Handicap 16 - 20 c) Division C : Handicap 21 - 24 d) Ladies Division : Handicap 0 - 36 e) Guests Division : Handicap 0 - 36

The Tournament Director and Organising Committee reserve the right to accept or reject entries and to adjust the handicap range of each division as it deems fit. Division A, B & C are NSMen. There will be no Ladies Division if there are less than 12 lady players, and they will compete in the Men or Guest Division accordingly.

Inter-Services Game

This will be a team event where every eligible player (NSMen and Ex-NSMen) will be grouped under the different services of the SAF (Army, Navy, Air Force as well as Digital and Intelligence). Every team must have a minimum of 4 players.

Handicap

Golfers must have an official handicap issued by a recognized club. Members of non-Singapore clubs must submit a copy of their current handicap card together with their entry forms. Golfers who are caddies, ex-caddies or staff of golf clubs must have their handicaps verified by the captains of their respective clubs.

Dress Code & Decorum

The Dress Code for all golfers is: Collared T-shirt and proper pants or shorts, and golf shoes with soft spikes. All Golfers are reminded of basic golfers' etiquette and courtesy when on the course.

Registration and Tee-off Time

Registration counter will be opened by 10am, 12.15pm for group photo taking, all golfers are to be ready by 12.20pm for shotgun tee-off at 12.30pm. Collection of scorecard, souvenir or goodie bag must be done by the player personally. They are also requested to ensure that their golf bags are loaded to the buggy accordingly by 12pm.

Teeing off at **WHITE** tee box for men and **RED** tee box for ladies. Latecomers will not be eligible for the H-I-O prize and will be disqualified. No substitution or mutual interchange of tee boxes shall be permitted after the draw has been made.

Speed-Up Play

Ball within putter length (excluding grip) is a "gimme" (pick up ball and add one stroke to your score). Golfers who are no longer in contention at any hole are to pick up their balls and proceed to the next tee.

Golfers are reminded to speed up play at all time. Flight with one empty hole gap behind the flight in front is considered as slow flight, all players in the slow flight will get two strokes penalty.

Scorecard Submission

All scorecards must be signed by the golfer and counter-signed by the marker before submitting to the Registration Counter. Scorecard must be submitted immediately after the game and it will be used for lucky draw during dinner. Scorecards are accepted with **Gross** score only, other forms of score recording will be disqualified.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather resulting in the inability for the championship to continue, the event shall stand if half or more of the golfers have completed play. The results shall be based on the returned scores. If the championship or any division is cancelled, the prizes of the division shall be awarded on the basis of a lucky draw. When warning of lightning is given, all golfers must stop play and proceed immediately to shelters.

There shall be no refund or raincheck given in the event of inclement weather.

Trophies & Prizes

Trophies will be given to the following:

- a) Overall Champion (Stableford) (NSmen from A, B or C division)
- b) Top 3 of each Division (A, B, C, Ladies, and Guests division)

In the event of a tie, the Keppel Club's count back system shall be used to determine the winner. In addition, attractive prizes will be awarded in each division and lucky draw for all players. Each competitor is allowed to win only **one** novelty prize except HIO.

Novelty Games

Hole-In-One (HIO): (For amateur golfers only)

Hole #3: MGS5, sponsored by Eurokars EV Pte Ltd

Hole #7: Harley-Davidson Nightster Special, sponsored by Ecorecom Branding Pte Ltd

Hole #11: \$50,000.00 Cash, sponsored by Fast Track Events Pte Ltd. Hole #13: \$50,000.00 Cash, sponsored by CloudX Entertainment Pte Ltd.

Winners of Inter-Services game will be determined by the aggregate stableford points of the **top 4 players** of each team. There will only be 1 winning team consisting of 4 winners.

Charity-on-the-Green:

All Par 3: At \$10 per ticket, if your ball lands on the Green after the tee-shot, every ticket is qualified for a special lucky draw. There is no limit to the number of tickets a golfer can buy. Golfers are also allowed to buy tickets on other golfers' tee-off results.

Nearest to the Pin:

All Par 3; Hole #3, #7, #11 & #13. Result recording will be done by the winner (Self-service). Winners are requested to write their names on the flag (provided at the novelty holes) if their results are better than the previous winner, and witnessed by their flight mates.

Putt for Charity:

There will be 2 putting lanes of 35ft putt setup at the practice green. For \$10 to charity, golfers will get 3 tries of putting. If a ball gets into the circle, the golfer gets 1 tube of golf balls. If a ball gets into the hole, the golfer gets 1 box of golf balls.

The Putt for Charity is opened from 10am to 3pm at the practice green on the tournament day. All players or non-players are allowed to have unlimited number of attempts, with \$10 for every 3 tries.

There will be a lucky player who is overall ranked at 35th position.

The Hole-in-one game is open until 7pm only. If more than one golfer scores a Hole-In-One, the prize will be shared equally amongst the winners. Any competitor who is currently in breach of the Amateur Status rules and is awaiting reinstatement, or without a valid handicap is not eligible to win the Hole-In-One (H-I-O) prize.

Dinner & Prize Presentation

A heritage-themed buffet dinner and prize presentation will be held at Keppel Club from 6.00pm. The actual time may vary depending on when the game ends.

Golfers are requested to be in proper attire (no singlet), and proper footwear (no slippers) during dinner. Dinner attendance is NOT transferable and is strictly for PRE-REGISTERED participating golfers ONLY.

All prizes must be collected personally after the dinner or thereafter at SAFRA Mount Faber by 31 Oct 2025 latest.

Tournament Director's Decision

All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred immediately to the Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final.
