

Entry Requirements

- 1) The completed model must be built and painted by the entrant
- 2) Participating model kits should be based on real-life subject that operates or visited Singapore dated from 1900 to present day. Examples of modelling subjects can include British/Allies and Japanese wartime period, Five Power Defence Arrangement (FPDA) or IMDEX participating ships in Singapore.
- 3) Entries which have been entered in any past competitions are allowed and welcome for participation.
- 4) There are three categories for entries:
 - Aircraft
 - AFV
 - Ship
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to reject and refuse to register any model submitted

Judging Criteria

- Construction (25 marks): Removal of gaps and seams
- Painting (25 marks): Quality of paint job and colour accuracy and paint scheme
- Finishing (20 marks): Overall appearance, weathering and realism
- Creativity (10 marks): Modification or conversion of existing base kit
- Presentation (10 marks): Example using a diorama to create an appealing setting
- Historical accuracy (10 marks): Markings, detailing and variant accuracy for the theatre of operation
- Difficulty multiplier (1.1 Factor)

All judges' decisions are final, and no appeals will be entertained

Prizes

For each category:

- 1st Place: \$50 SAFRA Rewards Voucher
- 2nd Place: \$30 SAFRA Rewards Voucher
- 3rd Place: \$20 SAFRA Rewards Voucher
